This exhibition features forty pieces of the most outstanding works selected from *The Illustrators Annual*, a competition open to artists worldwide. A jury of professional illustrators and art directors determines which pieces from thousands submitted will be included in the exhibition. *Illustrator 54* includes six categories – Sequential/Series, Uncommissioned, Editorial, Book, Advertising and Institutional. Works on view have appeared in magazine and newspaper publications, adult and children's books, calendars, theater posters, fashion labels, CD and album art, and advertisements for major corporations. This exhibition presents the year's finest illustrations.

Gold and silver medals are awarded to top illustrators. All accepted entries are lavishly reproduced in full color in the *Illustrators Annual Book* – the leading directory of American and international illustrators. This exhibition is organized and traveled by the Society of Illustrators in New York City.
