### Scholarships for the 2018-19 Academic Year

#### Application Materials:

- Create a SlideRoom “user” account
- Complete online application form
- Current (electronic) grade transcript
- Electronic recommendation form from at least one (1) faculty member familiar with your work
- One 5-7 page Art History research paper for Art History majors.  
**OR** Six (6) high-quality images of recent studio or graphic design work.

**formatting:** documents may be either a Word Document or PDF. Each page may have 1-3 images of one project (example: one overall shot, close-up, different angles). Each work must have the following information: title, medium, size, date, and description ( a few sentences of your concept / purpose ). For video work, images should be screenshots of your video. Add a link to the video, with a maximum of 60 seconds of run time.

#### In order to be eligible for these awards:

- 1) You must be a currently enrolled student in good academic standing working towards a degree in Studio Art, Art History or Graphic Design at OSU. During the period of your award, you must take at least 12 credits each semester (*unless otherwise indicated*).
- 2) You should have achieved sophomore status by having completed at least 30 credits *by the end of the summer 2018 term*.
- 3) Awards will be based primarily on achievement within the department, with consideration given to overall academic success. Therefore, your GPA , the quality of your submitted works of art or written work (for art history majors), and the letter(s) of recommendation submitted on your behalf are the main criteria used by the Scholarship Committee in the Department of Art, Graphic Design and Art History in making these awards.
- 4) In order to be competitive for these scholarships, your departmental GPA should be at least 3.25, with a minimum 2.5 GPA overall.

Application implies consent of the applicant to have his or her records, including transcripts, viewed by the members of the Scholarship Committee of the Department, Graphic Design and Art History. It also implies consent for submitted materials to become the property of the department and to be used for promotional purposes. Successful applicants will be informed of their award by the end of February.

### **GREEN COUNTRY WATERCOLOR ART SOCIETY AWARD: 1 award of \$600**

- Junior or senior (must have successfully completed at least 60 credits)
- Studio Art major
- Water media focus (painting focus if no eligible candidate meets that criterion)
- Must make presentation of work to society members
- Part or full-time student

### **ART SCHOLARSHIP Unendowed Fund: \$1,700 (1-2 awards)**

- No restrictions other than the recipient must be a full-time student in the College of Arts and Sciences and enrolled in Art Department classes. *Open to non-majors*

### **LYN GUNTER MEMORIAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIP: \$460 (1 award)**

- Applicants must complete 32 credit hours by end of summer 2018.
- Must have an overall GPA of 3.0 and an Art Department of GPA 3.5.
- Must be a Studio Art major

### **B.J. SMITH Endowed Scholarship Fund: \$1,500.00 (1-2 awards)**

- Full time junior or senior (as of fall 2018)
- Studio Art major
- cumulative GPA must be 3.0

### **J. JAY MCVICKER Endowed Scholarship in Art: \$2360.00 (2 awards)**

- Restricted to full-time students studying art. *MAY BE RENEWED*

**2018-19 Art Department Scholarships/Funds cont'd.**

**WAYMAN R AND DONNA SPENCE Endowed Art Scholarship (Medical Heritage):**

**\$6150.00 (6-8 awards)**

- Preference given to students with an Art Department GPA of 3.5 and a minimum 2.75 GPA overall
- Open to all full-time majors in the Art Department

**FRICKENSCHMIDT SCHOLARSHIP: \$950 (1 award)**

- Must be a junior or senior Studio Art Major, enrolled full-time

**SARAH CLARK MEMORIAL ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP: \$600 (one award)**

- Open only to Studio Art (preferred) or Graphic Design majors
- Must have successfully completed at least 94 credit hours

**BARBARA CHITWOOD ART APPRECIATION SCHOLARSHIP: \$3630 (3-4 awards)**

*NEW SCHOLARSHIP- QUALIFICATIONS TO BE POSTED*

**DALE MCKINNEY ART ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND IN HONOR OF ROBERT RAUSCHENBERG: \$1000 (ONE AWARD)**

- The recipient of the Scholarship in honor of Dale McKinney and Dean Bloodgood must be: enrolled as a full-time student at the University and must show great promise in painting and/or in the creation of other forms of two-dimensional art, including but not necessarily limited to photography and new media.

**THREE (3) ULAE INTERNSHIPS: Fall 2018, Summer 2019, Spring 2019**

All expenses paid, semester long internship in fine arts printing house outside of NYC

- Preference for students who have completed 60-93 credits (junior status)
- *Must return to OSU for at least one semester after the internship*
