

PRINT AND LASER COMBINATION

Lines to be cut need to have a weight of .001pt and no fill. Objects that are to be rastered need to have a fill or line weight above or equal to .5pt

Max paper space: 18 in X 24 in
Max image space: 17.75 in X 23.75 in

Paper size must be trimmed down to fit inside the laser cutters tray (max paper size 18 x 24")

Registration marks need to be included in **illustrator file** within image area, pdf must be saved with cropmarks.



.5" registration mark

All images must reside within the image area to prevent the laser from damaging the equipment (.25" within cut down page space)

FORMATTING YOUR PRINT

- Save illustrator document as a pdf with crop marks (max artboard size of 18x24").
- Export indesign document as a pdf with crop marks (each page/spread must be saved with its own crop marks)
- Registration marks must be on the illustrator document before printing.
- Multiple artboards can be printed on the same sheet of paper as long as they have their own crop/registration marks and do not exceed either width or height requirements of the laser cutter.
- Do not make changes to illustrator document between printing and laser cutting.
- In illustrator your printed images, registration marks, and cutlines (line weight .001) are required to be on separate layers.

DOUBLE SIDED PRINTING

- Make sure your artwork is centered
- The images or solid fills on the back of artwork should have bleeds
- Type on both sides? One side should be reversed in illustrator before saving as pdf
